

The Lee-Yung Family Prize for Entrepreneurship Application 2025

Guidance Notes

Through the Trinity Hall Entrepreneurs Network (THEN), the College is eager to promote innovation and entrepreneurship among its members and support students who are thinking of developing their own start-ups. The Network is designed to promote opportunities for students to be involved with entrepreneurship and to develop a network of like-minded alumni to share ideas.

The Lee-Yung Family Fund for Entrepreneurship compliments this program by providing students and recent graduates with funds they can use to help implement an idea. This could be through learning skills, accessing a makerspace or buying materials that will help them translate their ideas into useful products or services.

Each year up to 2027, £1,000 will be distributed across a selection of up to five teams or individuals who make the most promising application. At the end of the year, an additional £1,000 will be awarded to the team or individual whose concept or product is deemed to show the most promise by the lead donor and panel of Trinity Hall Fellows.

The award has been made possible by a donation from Dr Aaron Lee (1993).

Eligibility

Individuals and teams may enter, however, teams must contain at least one member who fulfills the eligibility criteria of a connection to Trinity Hall. To make an application you must be an undergraduate, graduate or post-doc affiliated with Trinity Hall; someone supervised by or working with a Trinity Hall Fellow; or a Trinity Hall alumnus within 5 years of graduation from either an undergraduate or postgraduate degree.

How to apply

Applications for the Lee-Yung Family Entrepreneurship Award should be made using the attached form and should be submitted to THEN@trinhall.cam.ac.uk. Application forms for resident members must also be signed by your Tutor. Supplementary information may be submitted alongside the application form.

The closing date for application is 9am on 10 February 2025. Funds will be distributed by the end of February. Prize recipients are expected to provide three updates on the progress of their initiative at approximately 3-month intervals.
